**Juanita Elaine GILL**

"Juanita Elaine (Gill) Weigler died unexpectedly at 12:43 pm, Saturday, March 27, 2004 at the age of seventy-seven. She was born in Thebes, Illinois on July 27, 1926, the daughter of the late Perry & Edna (Davis) Gill, and after the death of her mother when she was very young, she was raised by her loving stepmother, the late Ruby Gill. Juanita was a 1943 graduate of Alton High School and was a legal secretary at Cox, Smith & Basset in Wood River for three years before she and her husband opened the Weiglers Farm Packing in Jerseyville, a business they owned and operated from 1961 until its closing in 1975. Shortly after that, the two began managing apartment complexes and retired as managers of the Half Moon Village Complex in St. Louis. She married Edward Weigler on Dec 16, 1944 in Wood River and they shared nearly 52 years together before his death on November 12, 1996. Surviving are four sons and daughter in laws, Edward & Nancy Weigler Jr. of Illiopolis, Terry & Sandy Weigler, Rick & Marilyn Weigler, all of Jerseyville, and Larry & Daria Weigler of East Alton; 16 grandchildren; 13 great grandchildren; and a brother, James McCoy of Roxana. Preceding her in death were two brothers, Robert & Jack Gill."
